ORDINANCE NO. 1A-2

AN ORDINANCE

OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ABBOTT, POTTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
REGULATING THE DESIGNATION OF CERTAIN TOWNSHIP ROADS AS
JOINT USE ROADS/SNOWMOBILE ROADS IN THE TOWNSHIP OF
ABBOTT

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Abbott Township has determined that it is in the best interest of the residents of Abbott Township that the Township adopt a "Joint Use/Snowmobile" road designation ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Abbott has determined that un-regulated roads for joint use/snowmobile use pose a health, welfare and safety concern.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED and ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Abbott Township, as follows:

Section 1. Designation

The following roads shall be and are hereby designated as "Joint Use/Snowmobile" roads whereby snowmobiles shall share the roads with other licensed motor vehicles:

T416 Boone Run Road T417 Cross Fork Creek Road
T433 Rausch Road

SEVERABILITY. Should any section of this Ordinance or part thereof be declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity shall not affect the balance of the

Ordinance since it was the intent of the Board of Supervisors that said Ordinance would have been adopted even if such invalid provision had not been included.


REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.


