### **December 2, 2024 Meeting Minutes**

The monthly meeting of the Abbott Township Board of Supervisors was held on Monday December 2, 2024 at 7:00pm at the township building.

1. Present at the meeting were: Randy Culp, Beth Kreiser, Lee Gardner, Ken Loiacono, Cory Shifflett , Pat Schellhorn, Joe Schellhorn, and Kayson Shifflett
2. Meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman Lee Gardner at 7:00pm.
3. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.
4. Lee made a motion to approve the meeting minutes for the last meeting that was held on November 4, 2024. Randy seconded; AIF motion carried.
5. Lee made a motion to approve the financial reports as presented, second by Randy, AIF motion carried.
6. Lee made a motion to pay the bills. Randy seconded; AIF motion carried.

#### **CONTINUED BUSINESS:**

Lee reported that Cory has the truck set up for winter and was out cindering roads.

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Lee made a motion to approve the budget as presented and advertised. Randy seconded the motion, AIF motion carried.

Lee made a motion to approve naming Ken "Sharky" Loiacono to serve as the agent for the Designation of Agent Resolution for FEMA regarding the flooding from Debbie. Randy Seconded the motion, AIF motion carried.

Lee made everyone aware that there Jake Ostrom sent out a message notifying landowners that someone has been going around claiming to be the County tax assessor. The person is described as wearing a camo hat with a white beard. If anyone stops ask for ID, Jake is the only tax assessor for the county and will provide ID if asked, do not allow anyone access and notify local authorities.

Lee stated the Township received sub division plans for Milton Beacker and his land on Ives Hollow to divide 25.86 acres into 5 separate lots, this was approved and plans signed.

Lee made a motion to keep the 2025 millage rate the same as 2024 at 4 mills and keep the penalty rate at 5% and the earned income tax at 1%. Randy seconded the motion, AIF motion carried.

Lee made the comment that the Township is purchasing a Ford F600 truck to be set up similar to the F550. It is hard to get CDL drivers and this new truck will be nice to have around for this reason.
